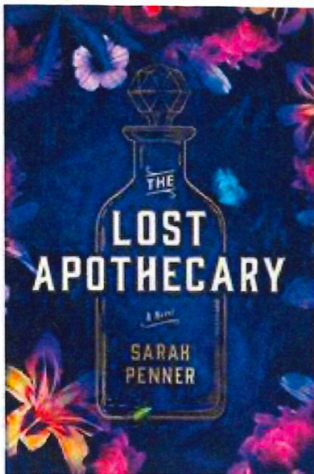

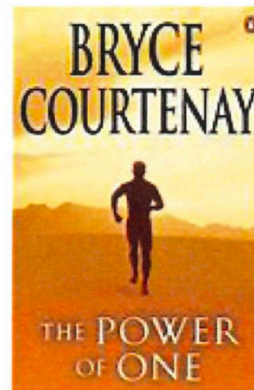
## CONNECTING OUR COMMUNITY

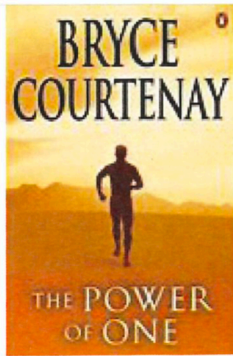

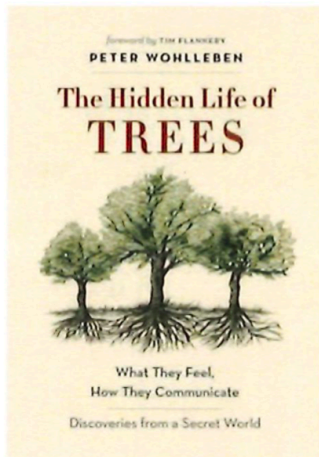

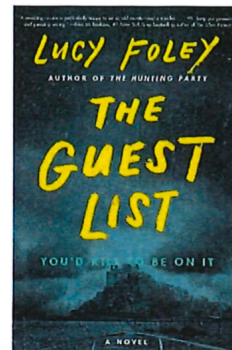
**April Book Club Pick!**

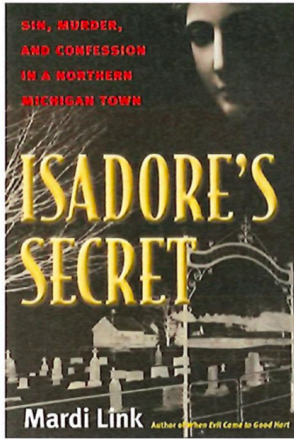


**Calling all book lovers!**

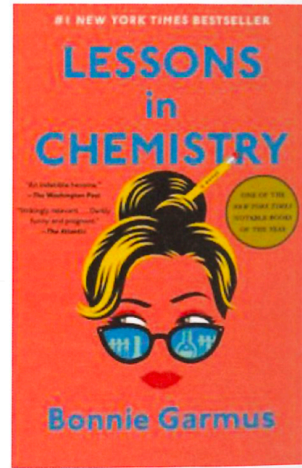


**June Book Club Pick!**

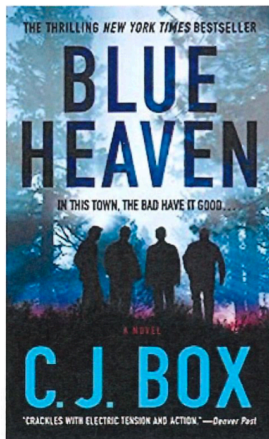
**July Book Club Pick!**

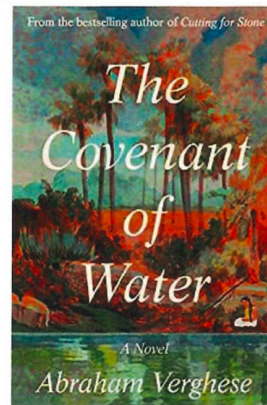

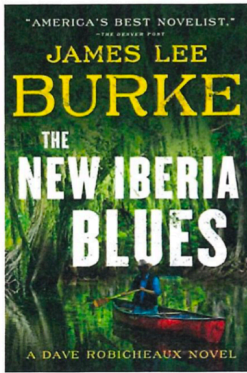
**September Book Club Pick!**

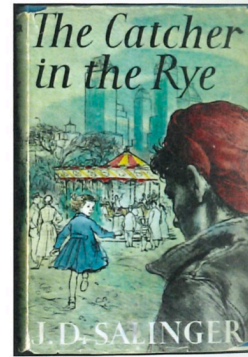
**October Book Club Pick!**

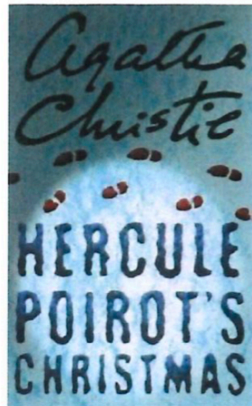
**November Book Club Pick!**

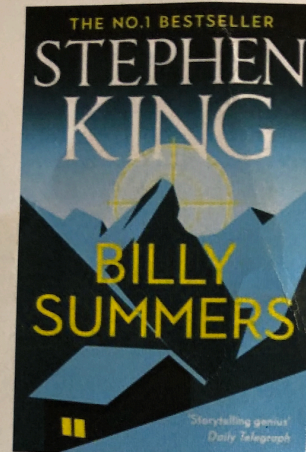
**December Book Club Pick!**
